Asking Where Someone Is From:

Tu es d'où?

Vous êtes d'où? = Where are you from? (Lit. "You are from where?")

Telling Where You Are From:

Je suis *des Etats-Unis. = I am from the United States.

*de la France	*du Japon
*du Canada	*de la Chine
*de l'Haïti	*de la Russie
*de la Suisse	*de l'Italie
*de l'Angleterre	*du Mexique
*de l'Allemagne	*de l'Espagne

Je suis de Grayson, Kentucky. = I am from Grayson, Kentucky.

How to welcome someone to your country:

Bienvenue *aux Etats-Unis! = Welcome to the United States!

(some French-speaking countries)

*en France	*au Canada
*en Haïti	*en Suisse

Asking Someone Where They Live:

Où est-ce que tu habites?

Où est-ce que vous habitez? = Where do you live?

Tu habites où?

Vous habitez où? = You live where?

How to respond if you are from and/or live in the same place as someone else:

Pareil! = means "Same here"

Moi aussi! = Me too!

Telling Where You Live:

J'habite à *Grayson, Kentucky. = I live in Grayson, Kentucky.

(some French-speaking cities)

*à Paris (France)	*à Toronto (Canada)
*à Port-au-Prince (Haïti)	*à Zürich (Suisse)
